Equipment User's Responsibilities

- Daily Pre-Trip Inspections
- Checking and Maintaining Fluids
 - Vehicles: At Refueling
 - Equipment: Daily
- Daily Greasing
- Proper Chain Tensioning in Track Machines
- Monitoring Tire Wear

Field Maintenance – Cont.

Equipment User's Responsibilities

- Monitoring of Buckets; Teeth; Cutting Blades
- Cleanliness (interior and exterior)
- Maintenance of Safety Features
- Proper Usage of Equipment
- Security (after hours)

Maintenance Manager: **Scott Burns**

- Part of Dispatcher Duties: Assigns and assures proper care of resources
- Frequent Site Visits to Verify Compliance
- Authority to Correct Deficiencies
- Coordinates with Larry Raymond
